What are Member Only training activities?	Training activities where only Canicross Midlands members participate.
Can I have temporary membership to be cover by the insurance?	No. The insurance cover is only for permanent members.
Do I need to sign a disclaimer to participate?	For Canicross Midlands organised events, where entry is purchased via the Canicross Midlands website, the disclaimer is part of the terms and conditions.     For Canicross Midlands organised training the disclaimer form will be provided by the training activity leader.
